## What Should You Bring With You to File Your Taxes?

- ◆ Copy of Last Years Income Tax Return(s)
- ◆ Your W2, Earnings Statements or Paystubs, All 1099's, and Proof of Unemployment Compensation
- ◆ Valid Picture ID for Taxpayer and Spouse (Driver's License, State ID or Passport)
- ◆ Social Security Card(s) or Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITIN) for All Family Members
- ◆ Social Security Numbers and Birth Dates of Dependents
- ◆ 1098's for Mortgage Interest or College Tuition & Real Estate Tax Statement
- ◆ Proof of Child Care Expenses
- ◆ Parcel Number (Illinois Homeowners Only)
- ◆ A Copy of a Voided Check or Bank Account and Routing Numbers for Direct Deposit
- ◆ All Receipts or Canceled Checks if Itemizing Deductions

**PLEASE NOTE:** If you are married and filing jointly, BOTH husband and wife MUST be present to sign all documents.

## LCCC/Alton Area Tax Project Information

NEW THIS YEAR. In order to reduce crowding, appointments will be required to have your taxes completed.

LCCC requires everyone to complete a Daily Self Certification form each day they enter the campus. The form may be found on their website <https://lc.edu> or the direct link is <https://form.jotform.com/201915937822056>

Appointments may be made online by visiting the Alton Area Tax Project Facebook page and clicking on the link or by calling (314) 539-4074.

Please do not make an appointment if you are sick or you believe you may have been exposed to COVID-19. Anyone with a temperature of over 100 degrees will not be allowed to enter.

In order to keep our volunteers and clients safe, the following procedures will be in place:

- A forehead thermometer will be utilized to check for a fever.
- Appointments are restricted to one person if filing single or two for couples filing a joint return.
- Clients must keep a six foot distance from other clients and volunteers.
- Please bring a mask. Clients must wear a mask covering mouth and nose.
